Some labels are easy to understand while others are more complicated. It is the users responsibility to read and understand the label before buying, using, storing or disposing of a pesticide.

Parts of the Label

- Trade, Brand or Product Name
- Use Classification Statement
- **Restricted or General Use Product**
- Type of Pesticide
- Ingredient Statement, Chemical Name, Common Name, Formulation Statement and Net Contents
- Name and Address of Manufacturer, Registration Numbers, Establishment Numbers
- Signal Words and Symbols, Precautionary Statements, Statement of Treatment
- Environmental Hazards, Physical and Chemical Hazards, Reentry Statement
- Endangered Species Restrictions
- Storage and Disposal
- **Directions of Use** - The Pest, The Plant or Crop, Proper equipment and mixing instructions, How much and how often, Compatibility with other products, Phytotoxicity, Where and when to apply, If it is labeled for chemigation

When to Read the Label

- Before you buy the product
 - Whether it is it the right pesticide
 - Whether it can it be used safely under your application conditions
 - Where you can use the pesticide
 - Whether you have necessary protective equipment
 - How much is needed for
- Before you mix
 - What protective equipment you need
 - What you can mix with pesticide
 - How much to use
 - How to mix
- Before you apply the pesticide
 - What safety measures to follow
 - Where pesticide can be used
 - When to apply
 - How to apply
 - Whether there are restrictions for use
- Before you store or dispose of the container
 - Where and how to store pesticide
 - How to decontaminate and dispose of container
 - What to do with surplus pesticide

Always read and follow label directions
It is the law
